Ripple Effects offers an easy-to-use set of planning assessment apps for creating individual and group interventions, and individual and group self-report tools for assessing social-emotional and behavioral strengths and school climate.

Planning

Individual Personalized Playlist Creator

This app allows staff to customize skill-building for their student by matching lessons from Ripple Effects research-based treatment plans to their student's learning objectives. Seamlessly connected to the Data Viewer, it is easy for users to quickly see what lessons students have completed. Treatment plans are designed to solve behavior challenges by addressing presenting behavior, and the reasons behind it. A personalized learning plan made up of multiple lessons can be spread out, or compressed, to fit a range of time constraint

Group Playlist Creator


This app allows implementers to tailor a curriculum to any group of students thy define, and allows assignment of preset curricula or specific topics to groups of students. The customized group playlists will then show up in each student's individual playlist in the student intervention program. At the end of the year, teachers or schools can evaluate the implementation by referring back to original goals and examining measures of success or progress, as well as decide on necessary adjustments based on changing circumstances.

Screen for Strengths

Identify strengths and opportunities for growth, and monitor progress toward targeted social-emotional competencies with this student self-report tool. Screen for Strengths aids educators in directing students to personalized, targeted interventions and reduces legal exposure possibly due to subjective, culturally biased assessment.







Group Seeing I to I

Identify potential trouble spots and build positive school climate with survey tool. Separate online surveys capture student, staff and parent perspectives of bias. The surveys focus on three areas related to respect: perceived adult behavior toward diverse groups, perceived student behavior toward diverse groups and personal attitudes about diversity.
